HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

Any ever numbered section of Dominion hands in Manitoda or the Northwest Territories, excepting 8 and 26, which has not been homesteaded, or reserved to provide word lots for settlers, or for other purposes, may be homesteaded inpute from purposes, may be formed to be a section of the property of the section of the acres, more or less than the jump of ago, to the extent of one-quarter sec-tion of 169 acres, more or less.

Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the District in which the land to be taken in situate, or if the homesteader desires he may, on application to the Minister of the Interior. Outswa, the Commissioner of Immigration, Winnipag, or the Local Agent for the district in which the land is situate, receive authority for some one to make unity for him. A few of \$10 is charged for a homestead entry

HOMESTEAD DUTIES.

A settler who has been granted an entry for a homestead is required by the provisions of the Dominion Lands Act and the amendments thereto to perform the conditions connected herewith, under one of the following plane:

(2) If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) or any person who is eligible to make a homestead entry upon the provisions of this a homestead entry upon the provisions of this hard entered for by such person as a homestead, the requirements of this Act as to residence prior to obtaining patent may be satisfied by such person residing with the father

(3) If a settler has obtained a patent for his homestead, or a certificate for the issue of seribed by this Act, and has obtained entry for a second homestead, the requirements of this Act as to residence may be satisfied by second homestead is in the vicinity of the first homestead.

(4) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his household, the requirements of this Act as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land.

The term "vicinity" used above is meant o indicate the same township or an adjoining or cornering township.

Every homesteader who fails to comply with the requirements of the homesteader law liable to have his entry cancelled, and the lar may be again thrown open for entry.

APPLICATION FOR PATENT

Should be made at the end of the three years before the Local Agent, Sub-Agent or the tion for patent the settler must give as months notice in writing to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa of his intention to do so.

INFORMATION

Newly arrived immigrants will receive at the Immigration Office in Winnipeg, or at any Dominion Lands Office in Mannibes, or the Jonnison Lands that are open for entry, and from the officers in charge, free of expense, advice and assistance in securing lands to suit them.
