An ACT to continue the several Acts of the General Assembly for granting to His Majesty certain dutics on Wine, Brandy, Gin, Rum, and other distilled Spirituous Liquors, Molasses, Coffee, and Brown Sugar, for the support of His Majesty's Government, and for promoting the Agriculture, Commerce and Fisheries, of this Province.

III. for granting to His Majest v certain duties on Wine, Brandy, Gin, Rum and other distilled Spirituous Liquors, Molasses, Coffee, and Brown Sugar, for the support of His Majesty's Government, and for promoting the Agriculture, Commerce, and Fisheries, of this Province: also the Act, made in the fitty-fixth year of His Majesty's reign, to alter and con- 56th Geo. III. tinue the aforesaid Act; and also the Act, made in the fifty-eighth year of His Majesty's 58th Geo. III. reign, entitled, An Act to continue and amend the several Acts of the General Assembly for granting to His Majesty certain duties on Wine, Brandy, Gin, Rum, and other distilled Spirituous Liquors, Molasses, Coffee, and Brown Sugar, for the support of His Majesty's Government, and for promoting the Agriculture, Commerce, and Fisheries of this Province; and every matter, clause and thing, contained in the said Acts, be continued, and the same continued. are hereby continued, until the eighteenth day of March, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty, and no longer.

CAP. V.

An ACT to continue an Act, for granting a Drawback of the Duties on Brown or Raw Sugar used in the manufacture of Refined Sugar within the Province, and for regulating the mode of obtaining the same.

E it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That the Act, passed in the 57th Geo. 111. fifty-seventh year of His Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act for granting a drawback of continued. the duties on Brown or Raw Sugar, uled in the manufacture of Refined Sugar, within the Province, and for regulating the mode of obtaining the fame, be continued, and every matter, clause and thing, therein contained, are hereby continued, until the eighteenth day of March, which will be in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and twenty, and no longer.
