On motion of Mr. Taschereau, seconded by Mr. Borgia,

RESOLVED, That a Committee of seven Members be appointed to inquire into the amendments to be made to the Militia Laws, and report with all convenient speed, by Bill or otherwise, with power to fend for persons, papers and records.

ORDERED, That Mr. Ta chereau, Mr Mure, Mr. Stuart, Mr Lee, Mr. Debarizch, Mr. Borgia and Mr. Coffin do compose the said Committee.

Mr. Borgia moved, seconded by Mr Taschereau, to resolve, that that part of His Excellency the Governor's Speech which relates to the Provincial Revenue of the Crown be considered in a Committee of the whole House to merrow.

The House divided on the question:

Yeas II Nays 4

So it was carried in the affirmative, and

RESOLVED accordingly.

On motion of Mr. Borgia, seconded by Mr. Bruneau;

RESOLVED, That that part of His Excellency the Governor's Speech which relates to Army Bills, be confidered in a Committee of the whole House on Monday next.
