

On motion of Mr. *Taschereau*, seconded by Mr. *Borgia*,

RESOLVED, That a Committee of seven Members be appointed to inquire into the amendments to be made to the Militia Laws, and report with all convenient speed, by Bill or otherwise, with power to send for persons, papers and records.

ORDERED, That Mr. *Taschereau*, Mr. *Mure*, Mr. *Stuart*, Mr. *Lee*, Mr. *Debarisch*, Mr. *Borgia* and Mr. *Coffin* do compose the said Committee.

Mr. *Borgia* moved, seconded by Mr. *Taschereau*, to resolve, that that part of His Excellency the Governor's Speech which relates to the Provincial Revenue of the Crown be considered in a Committee of the whole House to morrow.

The House divided on the question :

Nays 4

So it was carried in the affirmative, and

RESOLVED accordingly.

RESOLVED, That that part of His Excellency the Governor's Speech which relates to Army Bills, be considered in a Committee of the whole House on Monday next.
