His Excellency The Honorable John Henry Thomas Manners-Sutton, Lieutenant Governor and Commander in Chief, &c. &c. &c.

Fredericton, Thursday, 17th July, 1856.

HIS Excellency the Lieutenant Governor having been pleased, by Proclamation bearing date the thirtieth day of May last, to dissolve the late General Assembly, and to order that new Writs issue for electing Members to form a House of Assembly; and having by further Proclamation, bearing date the second day of July instant, summoned a meeting of the General Assembly to be holden on this day for the dispatch of business—
