*Thomas, Evan;* Petition of, for redress against alleged oppression on the part of the Sheriff of Prince County, read by a Member, 86. Motion that the Rule be suspended, and Petition received and read. Motion, in amendment, that it be not received, the remedy being elsewhere, carried. Main motion, as amended, put and carried, 87.

*Ways and Means;* Consideration of, made an Order of the Day, 65. Copy of communication from the Government of Nova Scotia, transmitting copy of an Act of Customs' Duties, of that Province, and of a Proclamation issued under authority of said Act, referred, 70. Considered, *ib.* Two Resolutions reported, and agreed to, 71, viz: First
