Tuber Diseases Of Potato

When digging potatoes, a number of diseases may be observed on the tubers for example, spots of corky tissue on the skin, called Common Scab; or black surface spots which cok like pieces of soil, but remain sticking to the tuber when it ie washed, this is the so called Black Scurf or Rhizoctonia. Again, one may also find a dry rot with white pustules breaking through the surface; in this case the cause is a Fusarium Dry Rot, which is nearly always associated with a crack or bruise of the tuber.
