At a recent meeting in the interests of the blind, held in the Church House of London, a blind stenographer, by the aid of a recently invented machine, took a verbatim report of each of the speeches. The system is the outcome of a prize offered two years ago by a Braille magazine, and is built upon several systems adapted to the Braille method of dots. These dots are embossed by the machine, which is noise-less, upon paper tape. This flows into less, upon paper tape. a basket, to be read back by the fingers of the stenographer and recorded on a typewriter.

A prize of \$100 has been offered by a Massachusetts physician, Dr. J. B. Learned, for the best essay containing some method for inducing sleep with-out the use of drugs.
