(a) Proclamation by the Royal Government-through all media of information--of a policy of
broad reconciliation which would make clear that
according to the letter and spirit of Article 6
and in terms of Paragraph 9 of the Final Declaration by the Nine Powers at Geneva nobody shall be
discriminated against for having "collaborated in
any way with one of the parties during the War."
No investigation into the problem of who was or
was not a member of the Khmer Resistance Forces
should be undertaken.

(b) The Proclamation shall also state that after a certain date any citizen found in possession of illegal arms will be prosecuted by due process of law. This date is to be determined by the Government, but should not be prior to August 22.
