check. If a discrepancy is found<sup>12</sup>, then the transaction log shall direct the initiating Party to terminate the transaction. If the initiating Party does not terminate the transaction, any units transferred in the transaction are "buyer liability" units until the discrepancy is rectified.

## 3. Work That Remains to be Done

Additional work related to the registries that remains to be completed includes the development of technical standards for national registries; the CDM Registry and transactions log; finalization of guidelines for reporting and review of information on national registries and assigned amount.
