Mr. Deputy Speaker: I declare the motion lost.

Mr. Lewis: Mr. Speaker, I rise on a point of order. Perhaps Your Honour might inquire as to whether or not the House, in the interest of proceeding with business, would be willing to apply the same vote to Motions Nos. 3, 4, and 7A.

Mr. Prud'homme: Mr. Speaker, I think we would be in agreement, with the condition that the name of the Hon. Minister of Supply and Services (Mrs. Vézina) who just came in is added. Otherwise, her vote would not be counted.

Mr. Lawrence: Mr. Speaker, I also rise on a point of order. That would require unanimous consent. I would be glad to add my consent, provided my vote is counted with the Government.
