An Essay Competition is open to undergraduates in any faculty or to graduate students proceeding to the Master's degree.

Two Gold, Two Silver, and Two Bronze Medals are offered.

Any one of the following subjects may be selected:

1. The Influence of the American Constitution on the Making of the British North America Act, 1867.
2. The Party System of Government in Canada since Confederation.
3. Confederation and the Development of Western Canada from 1867 to 1900.
4. Quebec's Part in the Confederation Agreements.
5. Joseph Howe and Confederation.
6. George Brown and Confederation.

Essays must not exceed 6,000 words.

Essays must be handed in to the Registrar on, or before, April 15th, 1933.
