19. In the absence of the Secretary from sickness or any Acting other cause, the Board may appoint from its staff an Acting Secretary. Secretary, who shall thereupon act in the place of the Secreary, and exercise his powers.

[20. The Chief Commissioner shall be paid an annual salary Salaries. of dollars, and the other Commissioners shall be paid each the annual salary of dollars. The Secretary shall receive a salary to be fixed by the Governor in Council, not less than twenty-five hundred dollars and not more

10 than thirty-five hundred dollars, annually. Such salaries shall be paid monthly out of the unappropriated funds in the hands of the Receiver General for Canada.]

[21. There shall be attached to the Board such officers, Staff of Board. 15 clerks, stenographers and messengers, as the Board, with the approval of the Governor in Council, from time to time appoints, at such salaries or remunerations as are recommended Salaries. by the Board and approved by Governor in Council. The Board may, at will, dismiss any such employee.

20 2. Whenever the Board, by virtue of any power vested in Payment of it by this Act, appoints or directs any person, other than a make enquiry. member of the staff of the Board, to perform any service required by this Act, such person shall be paid therefor such sum for services and expenses as the Board may, in such cases, de-25 termine.

3. The salaries or remunerations of all such officers, clerks, Salaries and stenographers, messengers, and appointees of the Board, and expenses of Staff, &c, how all the expenses of the Board of, and incidental to, the carry- to be paid. ing out of this Act, including all actual and reasonable travelling expenses of the Commissioners, Secretary, and of such members of the staff of the Board as may be required by the Board to travel, necessarily incurred in attending to the duties
