

country in Europe, including Russia, Austria, and Turkey. In Germany there are 121 Baptist churches, with 25,497 members; in Sweden, 298 churches and 18,851 members.

In India and Ceylon we had, in 1880, 147 churches and 25,488 members; in Burma, 433 churches and 21,594 members. Including those in all lands, we obtain the following numbers:
