FUTURES LACK STRENGTH ON SMALL ADVANCES

New Recent Low Level Made in Wheat Options at Chicago—Cables Also Lower.

World Office, Tuesday Evening, July 16. Liverpool wheat futures closed today at 10 1/2 lower and corn futures at 1/4 higher than yesterday.

The general weather conditions of week ending yesterday were favorable over most of the country. The drought prevailing at the close of the previous week in portions of Oklahoma, Missouri, Texas and Louisiana has been wholly or in part relieved and portions of the lower Missouri valley have experienced excessive heavy rains that caused damage in some places. Severe local storms were more numerous than in any previous week in the northern districts from the Missouri valley eastward, but southern states were comparatively free from such storms. There was much cloudiness in Texas, the Missouri Valley and middle Rocky Mountain region, but the normal amount of sunshine.

BERLIN.—From six to eight inches of rain have fallen throughout the greater part of Germany in the last three days, and as a result a number of rivers have overflowed their banks, carrying death and destruction into the surrounding country. Not less than a dozen minor railroads have been washed out. In the Rhine district reports and despatches coming in from the country traversed by the floods, describe the destruction of crops, dwellings and outbuildings. In the West, special reports from Western Germany state that the hay and rye crops in the Province of Brandenburg are entirely ruined by the prolonged rain, the farmers having had only one day for harvesting.
