Pauperism in New York State. New York, Nov. 20.—Official reports show that 2,551,455 applicants received assistance or relief from the various charitable institutions of New York State last year. The total amount of money expended for institutions of New York State last year. The total amount of money expended for charities last year by organized charities in this State was \$23,100,000. Of this \$9,606,136 was disbursed through purely official and \$13,494,754 through private agencies. In New York City the number of persons receiving assistance was 1,523,639. The hospitals, relief societies and other as sociations took care of 758,609 persons. The remainder received what is known as "outdoor relief"—that is, at their own homes. Pauperism has grown to such an extent that the enormous sum of \$103,384,554 is now invested in their behalf in this State.
