This, stripped down to fighting trim, means, in addition to all the questions covered by specific law, that the strikers dare not talk to, look at, or come within hearing distance of the scabs without danger of arrest for contempt of court. The court can be held in contempt so long as the contempt does not interfere with the terms of the injunction, but the use of pickets or appeal to the scabs to leave or remain out of the employ of the company is contempt within the meaning


