

COBALT---Mining Markets Less Active But Prices Are Steady---COBALT

MARKET STEADY AND FIRM BUT CHANGES ARE NARROW

Mining Specialties Are Less Active, But Prices Maintain a Steady and Firm Undertone.

Friday Evening, June 18.
Trading at the local mining exchange of late has kept up to the promise shown a few days since of a steadier and firmer market. Although transactions to-day were somewhat restricted, prices on the whole remained firm with few declines. The dealings during the first part of the week have made traders rather cautious in opening fresh commitments just at present, and until the air has cleared and public confidence has been fully restored, no movements of any account are likely to occur.

Temiskaming was in fair demand throughout the day, but there was no attempt made to force the stock, in fact the reverse seemed to be the case. Although the price of the shares was not materially changed, all offerings were picked up as fast as they were made, and quotations at the close were quite firm.

Beaver, which has been steadily forced down by professional selling, acted in a somewhat similar manner, the change of any account in the price of the shares.

In the other issues Nova Scotia, Oshawa, Rochester, Peterson Lake and City of Cobalt were all dealt in moderately, but quotations remained steady, and the shares were in fair demand throughout the day. Great Northern was dealt in to a greater degree than has been the case of late, but the price was not affected to any extent.

La Rose was by far the strongest issue in the market, considerable trading being done in these shares around \$7.25.

With the exception of the above the day's business was featureless. In general, opinion among local traders is for a better market in the near future.

NEW YORK, June 18.—The announcement by Edward F. Croker of his retirement as chief of the fire department yesterday afternoon, and his appointment as chief of the fire department of the city of New York, has caused a great deal of interest.
