The Secretary of the Church Endowment Committee submitted a Report of the state of that fund, which Report was adopted.

"It was resolved, that the Church Endowment Committee be recommended to send out two agents, one to the eastern and one to the western parts of the Province, to make arrangements for collecting the remaining subscriptions to that

"It was resolved, that the next General Meeting of the Society be held as near as possible to the time appointed for the meeting of the Synod."

Attention was drawn to the neglect of many of the parishes to make collection for the W. & O. fund.

"It was resolved, that this Society request the Bishop as Diocesan to bring this matter before the Clergy, and to impress upon them the necessity of making an annual collection in each one of their Churches for the W. & O. fund."

A Public Meeting of the Society was held in the Temperance Hall, Halifax, on the evening of Thursday, the 15th October, at 71 o'clock, P. M., at which the following Resolutions were adopted:

Moved by the Rev. George W. Hill, A. M., seconded by the Rev. F.

"Resolved that the quietness and prosperity with which God has blessed our Uniacke, jr. :-Church and our country should excite our heartfelt gratitude, and while it increases our trust in Divine protection should call forth greater exertions in spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ."

Moved by Professor Hensley, B. D.; seconded by Capt. Orlebar, R. N.,

and supported by W. M. Brown, Esq. :-

"Resolved, that a more united and vigorous effort be made by the Church in this Province to meet the diminution which the increasing demands upon its resourses have compelled the generous S. P. G. to make in its grants to this Diocese."

Moved by P. Lynch, Esq.; seconded by the Rev. H. L. Owen:-

" Resolved, that while recommending the several objects of this Society, we would particularly call the attentior of Churchmen to the necessity of making provision for Clergymen who may from any cause become incapacitated for further labor."
