Your Committee has to record its deep and gratefu sense of the services rendered by the collectors who have done their work faithfully and well. Vacancies have occurred during the year in some of the districts which have been promptly filled up.

Your Committee cannot close its report without affectionately urging those members of the congregation (not many) who are in circumstances to contribute to the funds of the Association and who have not contributed during the past year, to do so during that on which we have now entered. It is not less our privilege than it is our duty to contribute for the extension of those blessings to others which we ourselves so fully enjoy.
