second cabins. Seattle, Wash., Jan. 7--With hull, masts and spars white as snow, the crack American full-rigged ship Erskine M. Phelps, the swiftest sailing ship in the world, maker and holder of a score of records, arrived in Seat-tle's harbor on her maiden visit to Puget's Sound. Aside from her wonderful lines the vessel's records are marvellous. On whatev-er course the Phelps has piled she holds rec-ords for speed, hourly, raily and weekly. Perhaps the Phelps' proudest record, and one which has never been equalled, was made when she sailer from Norfolk to Honoiulu, a distance of 15,000 miles, in 97 days. Weather conditions considered, this record of 155 miles a day will probably stand for years.
