168 CONSTITUTION OF THE WOMAN'S MISSIONARY SOCIETY.

## ART. IX.—CHANGE OF CONSTITUTION.

This Constitution may be changed at any annual meeting of the Board of Managers by a two-thirds vote of each branch delegation, notice of such amendment having been given to each branch before its annual meeting; but Art. VIII shall not be changed, except with the concurrence of the General Board of Missions of the Methodist Church.

## BY-LAWS.

1. The Corresponding Secretary of each branch shall be required to furnish in her report, in schedule form, to the annual meeting of the Board of Managers, the following items:—
