## REGULATIONS

Adopted at the Annual General Meeting of the Society in 1826 and 1827.

I. That the fundamental law of the Society, which, nits its operations to the circulation of the Holy Scriptures, fully and distinctly recognized as excluding the circulation the Apocrypha.

II. That in conformity to the foregoing resolution no cuniary aid can be granted to any Society circulating the pocrypha; nor, except for the purpose of being applied conformity to the said resolution, to any individual hatever.

III. That in all cases in which grants, whether gratuitous otherwise, of the Holy Scriptures, either in whole or in rt, be made by the Society, the books issued be bound, d on the express condition that they shall be distributed thout alteration or addition.

IV. That all grants of Scriptures to the Society which culate the Apocrypha, be made under the express cond in the absenced tion that they be sold or distributed without alteration addition; and that the proceeds of the sale of any such pies of the Scripture be held at the disposal of the British d Foreign Bible Society.
