A posterior from our French correspondent, dated November 20, forwarded to the King of Prussia, Marshal Soult forwarded to the King of Prussia, to withdraw altogether, and break up the ministerial combination; his Majesty, after a short consultation with his ministers, had given his assent to the arrangement, and the discussions and the propositions set before him on the previous day as the principle of the future Cabinet.

It was thought that M. Thiers would withdraw his letter to the Marshal, and that Soult's ministerial movements would be completed. M. Villiers however, had now declared that he would not accept office.

Lord Elginford had lost his election in North Devon, and Mr. Burke, the Conservative candidate, was elected.

Mr. Papineau, from Canada, had arrived in Paris, Count Vaudier had been appointed to the command of St. Jean d'Uzes, from which fact it was inferred that the French Government intended to make use of forces as a guarantee for the sum which should be stipulated in the pact in Mexico, as an indemnity for the losses of French residents.

London, March 22.—A good deal of anxiety prevails among the foreign parties connected with the commerce of the United States, and especially the American colonies, in consequence of the unpleasant accounts respecting the disputed territory. People of the first information have to-day openly expressed their opinion that this repulse, for such it is, however it may be construed, will not only affect the commercial, but as far as related to the United States, the Government of which does not appear to have the power to restrain the leaders of the *Confederates* that affect the border frontiers of the *Confederacy*, and that it is to be presumed that our government alone is to be blamed for the implant of political parties which have for some time past, and our supremacy which it now appears expected that the despot of the world, who is a monarch of republics, would respect.

Brussels, March 22.—A report was circulated in this city as we went to press that a message was to be brought down to the House this evening relative to the supply of 20,000 additional troops to the army of the *Confederacy*, who were not quite satisfied.

There will, however, be an increase to the extent of six or seven thousand.

The House of Lords decided this morning (for their Lordships did not, on this occasion, close their sittings till the unusually late hour of 4 o'clock,) that they would not give a vote on the question of the trial of the Duke of Wellington, and the administration of the Marquis of Bute.

That motion was carried by a majority of 62. Nobles Lords having voted in favor of it, and 58 against.

Lord Melbourne resisted the appointment of the committee, from which he made it clear that no beneficial result was to be hoped for, not indeed did any of the Noble Lords who spoke in favor of the motion consider that the trial of the Duke of Wellington would have the effect of removing one of the existing evils of Ireland.

The motion, in point of fact, was merely one move in the tactics game, but was undoubtedly well timed, and would have been recommended before now, but it had been delayed by the want of a due course of legislation.

Such was the character of the motion to which the House of Lords assented this morning, and, precisely for that reason it obtained the port of Lord Birmingham.
