The recommendation then became the finding of the Synod. Mr. Hodnett gave notice of appeal from the finding of the Synod to the General Assembly, for reasons to be hereafter submitted. The Moderator appointed Messrs. Pitblado, MacBeth and John Paterson, to prepare answers to Mr. Hodnett's reasons for appeal, and to defend the Synod before the General Assembly.

The report on Finance and Statistics was presented by Prof. Baird, who moved the reception of the report and the consideration of its recommendations. The motion was duly seconded, the recommendations considered, amended and adopted. (See Appendix.)

The Committees to examine the records of Presbyteries, viz—Superior, Winnipeg, Rock Lake, Glenboro, Portage la Prairie, Brandon, Minnedosa, Melita and Regina, reported that they had examined the records of the respective Presbyteries and that they found the same carefully and correctly kept, and recommended Synod to attest the several records accordingly. The recommendations were adopted by the Synod.

The Synod then adjourned to meet at half-past two o'clock, the Moderator pronouncing the benediction.

NINTH SEDERUNT.

At the same place as above the Synod met pursuant to adjournment, and after praise was constituted by prayer by J. A. F. Sutherland, at the request of the moderator.

The minutes of the preceding sederunt were read and sustained.

Mr. Rowand presented the report of the Committee on Standing Committees, including Committee on Travelling Expenses. The report was considered seriatim and adopted as a whole, as follows:—
