Eld. s. of André Gerin-Lajoie, Esq., of Yamachiche, P.Q., by Ursule Caron, dau. of Chas. Caron, Esq., who represented St. Maurice in the L.C. Assembly for a considerable period. B. at Yamachiche, 1824. Ed. at Nicolet College. M. Mdle. Dupont (she d.) A mill owner and manufacturer. Sat for present seat, in Can Assembly, from g.e., 1863, until the Union. First returned to Commons at last g.e. A Liberal, and a supporter of the Mackenzie-Dorion Administration.—*Yamachiche, P.Q.*

Landerkin, George, M.D. [*South Grey.*]

S. of the late Mr. James Landerkin, a native of N.S., who settled in Co. Simcoe, Ont., 1824. B. in West Gwillimbury, Simcoe, 20 July, 1839. Ed. at Victoria College, Cobourg, where he graduated as M.D., 1862. M., 15 Feb., 1870, Miss Kirkendall, of Elora, Ont. First returned to Commons at last g.e., 1872; re-elected at last g.e. A Liberal, and a supporter of the Mackenzie Administration.—*Hanover, Ont.*
