An Act respecting the Brandon and South-western Railway Company.

MHEREAS the Brandon and South-western Railway Company has, by its petition, prayed for the passing of an Act to extend the time limited for the commencement and completion of its railway, and it is expedient to grant the 5 prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:-

1. The time limited for the commencement of the railway Time for of the Brandon and South-western Railway Company, and construction extended. 10 for the expenditure of fifteen per cent on the amount of its capital stock, as required by section 89 of The Railway Act, is hereby extended for a period of three years from the first day of November, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight; and if such expenditure is not so made, or if the railway is not 15 finished and put in operation within five years from the said first day of November, one thousand eight hundred and ninetyeight, then the powers of construction granted to the said company shall cease and be null and void as respects so much

2. Any Act hereafter passed for the purpose of controlling Power of railway companies incorporated by or subject to Parliament as Parliament to the issuing of stock or bonds, and as to rates or tolls and legislation. the regulation thereof, and as to running powers over or other rights in connection with the railway of any Company by any 25 other company, and the exercise of powers conferred upon railway companies, shall apply to the said company from the time such Act goes into effect; but this section shall not be construed to imply that such Act would not apply to the said
