## INSTRUCTIONS.

Preliminary Remarks:

The services to be rendered by the surgeon superintendent may be divided into his Division of the following duties,—1st, on joining the ship; 2d, at the time of the people's embarkation; 3d, during the voyage; and 4th, after the voyage is over. The following instructions will be divided into heads corresponding with these periods, and each will be rendered as complete as circumstances admit; but it will not the less be the business of the surgeon superintendent to make himself acquainted with the whole, and to apply to any defective or doubtful point in one part of the instructions whatever light can be derived from another.

Terms of remuneration.

It may be observed that the terms of the surgeon superintendent's remuneration are stated in a separate paper, and that in the same place it is explained that he is to be provided by the master with a suitable mess, according to the regulations therein laid down.
