

to the Secretary Department of Indian Affairs
Ottawa

Sir: With reference to request contained
in letter dated, Ottawa 22nd May, No 184632-
in the matter of the survey of the Indian lands
at Fisher's Grant, I wish to state that the
survors charge three dollars per day, and
it may take three days to finish the
work - it may take three men with
the survor. in all it may cost from
twelve to fifteen dollars to complete the
survey. The lines to be surveyed are
the boundaries between Indian lands and Jas.
G. Speak, as marked on plan, commencing
at the main public highway at the North West
corner of lot No 24 B, and thence along the dividing
line between Jas. G. Speak and Indian land as contained
in lot No 24 A, and also the line on the North East
side between Indian lands contained in lot 24 C
and Mr Scott - McKinnon marked on plan.
It may also be necessary to survey lot No 24.
