

9. The Province undertakes that none of the monies made available under this Agreement shall be expended without Provincial control of the municipal administration thereof satisfactory to the Minister unless the municipality contributes a minimum of 20 percent of the total expenditures made in said Municipality during the term hereof for Material Aid.

10. It is agreed that no person other than a resident of Canada shall be eligible for Material Aid, and that no person shall, in relation to his or her eligibility for said Aid, be discriminated against nor favoured by reason of his or her race, religious views or political affiliations.

11. It is understood that the Dominion will not contribute to the cost of Provincial or municipal Material Aid administration.

12. The Province agrees to maintain adequate records of all expenditures incurred in respect of Material Aid to which it requests the Dominion to contribute under this Agreement, such records to be segregated from, although reconciled with, the continuing books of accounts of the Province, and undertakes to furnish such information and produce such records, documents and files directly or indirectly connected with the giving of said Aid and/or the operation of said agreement as officers of the Dominion may deem necessary to permit full examinations and audits of related accounts to be made.

13. The Province undertakes, in respect of each statement of municipal expenditures submitted under the terms of this Agreement for Dominion contribution, that the municipality incurring the expenditure has maintained adequate record of account thereof, segregated from but reconciled with the continuing records of the municipality, and, further undertakes that the municipality will, upon request of the Dominion made to the Province, furnish such information and produce such
