Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 27th ultimo and to say that you may appoint James Washishkung as foreman in charge of the work on the roads in the Spanish River Indian Reserve. It is presumed that he will work with the men but will be paid about half a dollar extra per day. It will only be necessary for you to visit the work when completed and report if the money has been economically spent and the work done to good advantage. You should direct of course where or at what points on the roads the work is to be done and under no circumstances is the expenditure to exceed the amount provided, viz., \$200.00, and the

necessary pay rolls and vouchers should be forwarded as usual to the Department.
