- Did you go up the narrow alleyway, or laneway leading up to the Square at any time that evening? 4.3
- A.3
- Did you go up any narrow laneway, alleyway or road way off high street. Q.4
- Yes, we went up a narrow street which leads to the A.4 angel.
- Did you leave the high street at any time to urinate? 0.5
- No. sir. A. 5
- Did you see Tpr Smyth urinate anywhere other than in 2.6 a proper lavatory?
- No, sir. A.6
- Who beside yourself and Smyth were around when the civilian tried to hit Smyth? 0.7
- I couldn't say sir, I don't know how many were around. A.7
- During the conversation between yourselves, the civilian and the provost did the civilian try to hit Smyth? Q. B
- I don't know if he tried to hit him but he was waving his hand in front of Smyth's face.
- Did the civilian make a threstening gesture towards 0.9 Smyth.
- I don't know, sir. A.9
- While the provost were on the scene did the civilian do anything to cause Smyth to step back in self-defence? 2.10
- I don't know, sir, A.10
- Were Smyth and the civilian engaged in fighting or 2.11 wrangling when the Provost came on the scene?
- The civilians came on the scene with the provost. A.11
- When did you first see the shorter of the two civilians? Q.12
- When he tried to hit Smyth. A.12
- Were the Provost present when he tried to hit Smyth? 2.13
- No, sir. A.13
- What happened efter the civilian came up and tried to hit Smyth? 2.14
- Smyth, grabbed him and held him away from him, then shoved him away and we turned and started walking down the street. We had gone a few yards when the civilian A.14 and the Provost stopped us.

The accused declines to pross-exemine the witness further. Janel.
