OCTOBER.—We shall not charge anything extra for a piece of advice respecting balky horses. It is seldom right to whip, kick or scold a balky horse. One of the best modes is to feed him where he stands, with any accessible food such as oats, ears of corn, or even grass from the wayside, or hay from the waggon; almost any palatable thing for an emergency. Seeming to forget his whim, he will generally start without trouble. Or, do something new, but not startling, as for instance filling his mouth with dirt. He will be diverted by the effort to empty his mouth, and perhaps jog on. If one can spare the day, it is best to wait till, from weariness and hunger, the animal submits himself to you. This last is generally a complete triumph, but the other methods often effectually succeed.
