1. Define the terms "Floating" and "Moveable" Kidney. Give the symptoms and treatment.
2. Enumerate the various kinds of Ulcer which occur on the tongue. State briefly the causes and characters of each.
3. What symptoms would cause you to suspect Tubercular Disease of the Knee Joint? What treatment, short of Excision, might you adopt?
4. Describe the Femoral Ring. Given a case of Hernia, what symptoms would indicate "Strangulation"? Under what circumstances is Taxis contra-indicated?
5. How do Ligature, Tortion and Acupressure act in arresting hemorrhage from a severed artery? What are their relative advantages under different circumstances?
6. Describe accurately the situation and extent of the skin incisions in performing the operations of: (a) Tracheotomy; (b) Lumbar Colotomy; (c) Inguinal Colotomy; (d) Suprapubic Cystotomy; (e) Lateral Lithotomy.
7. What are the diseases of the Testicle in which you would perform Castration? Describe the operation, and give the names and derivation of the arteries divided.
8. Describe the two most frequent Dislocations of the Shoulder Joint. State how they may be distinguished from each other and from other injuries about the joint.
9. What are the causes of Delayed Union and of Non-Union after fracture of a long bone? Describe the treatment you would adopt to obtain union in each variety.
10. Describe briefly the process of separation of Necrosed Bone when invaginated. What operative measures would you adopt for its removal? Name all the instruments required for such an operation.
