ANNO DECIMO QUARTO

VICTORIÆ REGINÆ.

At the General Assembly of Her Majesty's Island of Prince Edward, begun and holden at Charlottetown, the Fifth day of March. Anno Domini 1850, in the Thirteenth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lady VICTORIA, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen, Defender of the Faith :

And from thence continued by several Proro- ALEXABDER gations, to the Twenty-fifth day of March, 1851, and in the Fourteenth Year of Her said Majesty's Reign; being the Third Session of the Eighteenth General Assembly convened in the said Island.

CAP. I.

An ACT to regulate the laying out and altering of Highways.

[Passed April 23, 1851.]

THEREAS it is deemed expedient to consolidate and reduce into one Act the several Acts of the General Assembly of this Island, relating to the laying out and altering of Highways: Be it therefore enacted, by the Lieutenant 1851.
