The Price of Potatoes.

After a careful enquiry regarding the supply of potatoes in the country, the Department of Agriculture at Ottawa has made the surprising announcement that there are in Canada about two million bushels of potatoes more than is usually required for seed and food purposes

So it seems there was no good reason at all for the three and four dollar per bag prices which prevailed a few weeks ago. The high prices may be attributed to something like panic on the part of the public and hold-up by the middle

The middle-men who dea! in food stuff which are necessary to healthful and comfortable living certainly must be put'under restraint. There is now no imit to the organization of capital and the combination of businessmen to achieve a set purpose. The grain trade of even such countries as Canada and the United States can be "cornered". The meat trade in large centres is manipulated so as to greatly increase the cost to the consumers, and the same is

true of eggs, butter and, in fact, all stable articles of food. This report by the Dominion Depart

ment of Agriculture is most timely and enlightening. It should put the public upon guard against corners and panic prices, and it should also result in such pressure of opinion upon government that steps will be taken to prevent the recurrance of such abuses in the future. It is however, an extremely difficult


