A Unique Cloud Bank.

A singular atmospheric phenomenon recently noted along the western coast of South America is a bank or band of cloud extending for two thousa miles, from Ecuador to the centre Chili, and following the trend of the coast range of hills. The cloud band is between ten and twenty miles broad,

is between ten and twenty miles broad, floats at an elevation of between two thousand and three thousand feet and has a vertical thickness of not less than one thousand feet.

This cunious phenomenon is ascribed to the prevalence of cool southerly and south-westenly winds blowing obliquely along-shote, and having their moisture condensed by the coast hill range just sufficiently to produce clouds without rain.
