The Manchester Guardian regarded as one of the leading Liberal papers says: "It is impossible not to suspect that the execution of Benton was no better than murder. The facts are pretty clear, but it is difficult to draw any lesson from them except that the Mexican leaders still conduct their warfare with the barbarity of the middle ages and that President Wilson would be far from the end of his difficulties even though General Huerta were driven from power."
