National Division Sons of Temperance in Session.

Over one hundred delegates from all parts of the United States and Canada assembled in St. Paul's Hall, Halifax, Wednesday morning, July 12th, for the annual meeting of the National Division of the Sons of Temperance. Wednesday and Thursday were devoted to an elaborate programme of business sessions, ritualistic ceremonies and social meetings.

Wednesday morning was given entirely to a business session at which were read the reports of the Most Worthy Patriarch, Most Worthy Scribe, and Most Worthy Treasurer. The report of the Most Worthy Patriarch, Rev. R. Heley Stavart, Norton, New Brunswick, dealt in a most comprehensive manner with the outlook for temperance in general and the activities of the Sons of Temperance in particular.

At 4.30 p.m. there was a Band of Hope demonstration and in the evening at 8 p.m., a reception to the National Division, Grand Worthy Patriarch B. O. Davidson of Wolfville, presided and speeches of welcome were delivered by Lieutenant and Governor McKeen and United States Consul General Young and others.
