The appointment of an agent does not work out satisfactorily in the majority of cases, as the general manager handles United Kingdom lines as well.

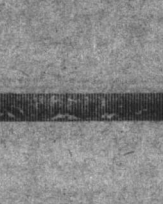

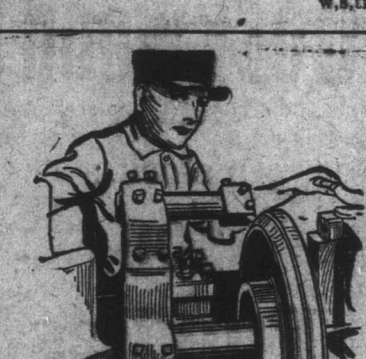
