

No. 102—Lien's Alternate Corrugated Bouble Plate . . 14¾ ozs.

Possesses every qualification of a First-class Pedal; has a very attractive appearance; is plated on copper, and has a perfect offing apparatus in a dust-proof cop; three-point contact bearings. We direct special attention to Nos. 100 and 102. These are a men's combination; stee in lieu of rubber, and are formed by a double steel side plate with a double alternate corrugated tread, which takes firm hold of the boot without the slightest in use than is the rubber. They have none of the disadvantages of the ordinary rat-trap, and are light, strong, and exceedingly handsome. We consider

them greatly superior in every respect to any other man's pedal now in use. To all riders we would say that the "Diamond" Pedal will add materially to the beauty of your wheel and to your pleasure and comfort while using it.
