unto Him.

At mid-day Saint Paul was con-  
verted and called to be an Apostle  
to the Gentiles.

on the house-top praying, and re-  
ceived the three-fold vision of  
the ingathering of Gentiles.

The Missionary Council, at Chic-  
ago, in 1893, adopted a resolution  
that during the continuance of the  
Council, a pause should be made  
each day at twelve o'clock for brief  
prayer for the coming of Christ's  
Kingdom in all the world, and  
recommending the custom of noon-  
day prayer for missions to all  
gatherings of Churchpeople, and  
to the clergy and mission stations  
at home and abroad.

The Church of England Mission-  
ary Conference, held in London,  
May, 1894, adopted the custom of  
noonday prayer upon the sugges-  
tion of the American Church, and  
in their report said: "The confer-  
ence is now a thing of the past.  
Is it too much to hope that at least  
one permanent memorial of it may  
remain amongst us, and that from  
many of our churches the noontide  
bell may call us, in the field, the  
workshop, or the mart, to lift our  
hearts, at any rate for a moment,  
in prayer for all the missions of  
the Church of Christ."
