The David Morrice Convocation Hall, Gray, Dining Hall, Reading Room, Studies, and Gymnasium are now completed forming with the original College buildings one of the finest externally equipped theological institutions on the continent. The situation is most healthy, commanding a good view of the city and the scenery of the St. Lawrence. The advantages of Montreal are unsurpassed. Students are provided, free of expense, with well furnished rooms, heated with hot water and lighted with gas. No fees are charged for lectures or classes. Board, \$12 per calendar month.

The next Session opens on 3rd October, 1883, and closes on 4th April, 1884.
