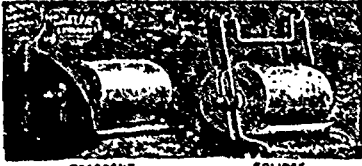

JOHNNYCAKE.—Two-thirds of a teaspoonful of soda, three tablespoonsfuls of sugar, one teaspoonful of cream of tartar, one egg, one teacupful of sweet milk, six teacupfuls of Indian meal, three tablespoonsfuls of flour and a little salt.

WAFFLES WITHOUT EGGS.—A table-spoonful of lard put into a teacup of corn meal; pour scalding water on all until it is as thick as mush; put into this one pint of buttermilk, half a teaspoonful of soda and one pint of flour; bake in waffle-iron.

CREAM BISCUITS.—Six eggs, separate the yolks and whites, beat the former with six ounces of powdered sugar and the same of flour, whisk the whites and mix them together, add to it whipped cream in proportion to the sugar and flour, stir it carefully. Pour this into moulds or paper cases and bake.

MEAT FOR HASHING OR MINCING.—Meat that is to be hashed, or used on a second day in any way, would always be much better if the slices were cut from the joint or large piece as soon as it leaves the table and soaked in the gravy of the dish until the next day.

ORANGE CAKE.—Two cups sugar, half cup butter beaten to a cream, one cup sweet milk, three eggs well beaten, three cups of flour, and two teaspoonfuls baking powder. Bake in sheet. Frosting.—Whites of two eggs, make a frosting as for other cakes; save out enough to frost the top of the cake, add to the rest the juice and grated rind of an orange, and spread between the layers.

TO REMOVE INK FROM CARPETS.—Ink which has been spilled on carpets or woollen goods should be attended to while wet, if possible. Take clean blotting paper or cotton batting, and gently sop up all the ink that has not soaked in. Then pour sweet milk on the spot, and sponge it with fresh batting. It will need to be renewed several times, using fresh milk and batting each time. Do not rub the spot, but sop it with care in order not to spread the ink. After the ink has disappeared, wash the spot with clean water and dry with a cloth.
