rule to do all the operations at one sitting, such as dilatation, curretting, amputation of cervix, repair of perineum, repair of cystocele, removal of pus tubes and ventrofixation all at one sitting. No one, therefore, should undertake the repair of a lacerated cervix, unless he is competent to diagnose retroversion and diseases of the tubes and ovaries, the necessary knowledge for which can only be obtained by frequent examinations of women in health as well as of those in every stage of pelvic disease.
