

KENYA/CANADA TRADE

Canadian trade relations are governed by GATT.

Canada extends to Kenya Preferential Tariff Treatment and received most favoured nation treatment in return.

Canadian sales to Kenya in 1978 were largely made up of machinery and transportation equipment. Canadian sales in 1978 were substantially above the normal pattern due to the commercial sale of military aircraft and communications equipment.

Canadian imports from Kenya - agricultural products (tea, coffee, cashew nuts).

Canadian companies have expressed a continuing interest in selling technical expertise and equipment to Kenya. In addition several groups have had discussions regarding possible joint ventures in Kenya.
