the Parliamentary Press Gallery in Ottawa, however, will be accepted from the individuals concerned, but should be accompanied by the above-mentioned personal photographs.

Applications should contain the following information:

- a. Full names and birth dates of persons to be accredited.
- b. Category, e.g. reporter, photographer, commentator, technician or supporting staff, such as messengers.
- c. Area of coverage, e.g., Charlottetown only, Québec only, Ottawa only, two cities, or all three.

Credentials will not be transferable. If found in the possession of unauthorized persons, they will be impounded. Loss of credentials should be promptly reported to the Accreditation Office.

In most cases, credentials will be forwarded by mail after accreditation applications have been processed. For the convenience of late applicants and certain non-Canadian media representatives, last-minute credentials may be obtained from Committee representatives located in the press centres at Charlottetown, Quebec and Ottawa, but not without delay.
