

WITH THE HYDRO-ELECTRIC POWER COMMISSION OF ONTARIO, WHICH HE JOINED IN 1919 AS AN ASSISTANT POWER PLANT OPERATOR. IN 1950 HE WAS APPOINTED TO HIS PRESENT POST OF PLANTS SUPERINTENDENT IN CHARGE OF FOUR HYDRAULIC GENERATING STATIONS IN THE RENFREW AREA OF NORTH-EAST ONTARIO. HIS LARGEST PLANT IS CHENEAUX, WHICH IS SLIGHTLY SMALLER THAN THE WARSAK PLANT, AND WAS DESIGNED AND EQUIPPED BY THE SAME CANADIAN COMPANIES WHO DESIGNED AND EQUIPPED THE WARSAK PLANT.
