Province of Ontario.

Province of Quebec.

Moose, (females); up to 15th Oct., 1888, after that date same as males.			

Penalty \$30 to \$50. Snaring, trapping, &c., prohibited; penalty \$1 to \$10. Not more than 2 Moose, 3 deer or 2 Caribou to be taken or killed by any person in any one season: penalty \$30 to \$50.

Penalty \$10 to \$25. Snaring, trapping, &c, (except Partridges) prohibited. Not to be hunted between one hour after sunset and one hour before sunrise. Decoys not to be exposed during same hours; penalty \$10 to \$25. Guns of larger bore than No. 8 prohibited; penalty \$2 to 10.

Other birds, (except Eagles, Falcons, Hawks, Wild Pigeons, King Fishers, Crows, Ravens, Waxwings, Shrikes, Jays, Magpies, Sparrows and Starlings) 1st Mar. to 1st Sept.

Penalty \$2 to \$5. Snaring, trapping, &c., forbidden; penalty \$2 to \$5. Any person may destroy Nets, Traps, Snares, Cages, &c. After the first ten days of the close season, Railway, Steamboat Companies and others are forbidden to carry any Moose, Cariboo, Deer or any part of same; penalty \$30 to \$50.

Disturbing or taking the eggs of Wild Duck, Teal, Wild Goose or Swan is forbidden; penalty \$10 to \$25.

No person not domiciled in the Province of Quebec or Ontario is allowed to hunt at any time in the Province of Quebec, without having obtained a license from the Commissioner of Crown Lands.

The export of Deer, Wild Turkeys and Quail in carcase or parts thereof from the Dominion at any time is prohibited; penalty \$100 and forfeiture. Customs Officers may seize same on reasonable cause for suspicion of intention to export. (See Customs Act 1883.
