BILL 12.

An Act to incorporate the Great West Fire Insurance Company.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that Preamble. it be enacted hereinafter as set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent 5 of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. Edward Lindsay Elwood, John F. L. Embury, Walter Incorpo-B. Scott and Wilson M. Graham, all of the city of Regina ration. in the province of Saskatchewan, solicitors, together with 10 such persons as become shareholders in the company, are hereby incorporated under the name of the "Great West Corporate Fire Insurance Company," hereinafter called "the Comname. pany."

- 2. The persons named in section 1 of this Act shall be Provisional 15 the provisional directors of the Company.
 - **3.** The capital stock of the Company shall be one million Capital stock. dollars, which may be increased to two million dollars.
- 4. The amount to be subscribed before the general Subscription meeting for the election of directors is called shall be two election of directors.
